Instructions

- ⇒ Read wherever and whenever! Each participating kid fills out his or her own log to keep track of the books read alone, aloud, with family, at story times, in school, at home, in a park. Each kid who submits a log listing six or more books at the end of the program gets to pick out a prize book of his or her choice!
- ⇒ As your program wraps up, the contact person gathers the individual logs and fills out this cover sheet with the names of each kid who read six or more books, the number of prize books needed, and age or preferred reading levels for prize books. Already have a typed up list of participating kids' names or just prefer to type? You can attach it to the cover sheet in lieu of handwriting the names. Then contact _____ to arrange a book drop off. Please allow at least 72 hours to schedule drop off.
- ⇒ Kids still working on their 6 books can drop off their logs at any of our 5 libraries - Main, West Wyandotte, South Branch, Turner Community, and Mr. & Mrs. F.L. Schlagle - or at our awesome Mobile Library (check out where it is today at twitter.com/kckpl) until August 6th to claim their prize book.
