


KCKPL eCard: Get immediate access to KCKPL eContent

If you already have a personal Kansas City, KS Public Library card, you're already a member and don't need to sign up for an eCard.

To sign up for an eCard:

1. Go to KCKPL eCommunity located at <https://ecomunity.kckpl.org/>
2. Select the "Get a Card" box located in the top right-hand corner
