



## KCKPL Exhibit Space Specifications

### **Main Library—625 Minnesota Avenue**

The primary exhibit space is located on the east side on the first floor in the café area and is 29 linear feet (35 with a break of about 6 feet for 2 windows). There are additional spaces on the west side of the first floor (16 linear feet) and the back of the first floor (20 linear feet) should more space be needed. The space will accommodate hanging pieces of greatly varying size. There are also two free-standing locking exhibit cases for 3 dimensional work that are 24 in by 24 in by 59 in. The space is brick and lit by natural and artificial lighting.

### **South Branch Library—3104 Strong Avenue**

The exhibit space is located in the middle of the library directly in from the front doors. The space consists of an open gallery with a total of 40 running feet. The space is white painted walls lit by natural and artificial lighting, including track lighting.

### **Mr. and Mrs. F.L. Schlagle Library—4051 West Drive, Wyandotte County Lake Park**

The exhibit space at the Mr. and Mrs. F.L. Schlagle Library is located across from the conference room on the upper level. The space consists of a 25 foot long by 8 foot tall wall that is lit by track lighting. Please note that only nature-themed artwork is accepted at this location.

### **West Wyandotte Library—1737 N. 82<sup>nd</sup> Street**

The exhibit space at the West Wyandotte Library is located on the first floor of the facility. The space consists of two main exhibit areas: the **Fine Arts Gallery** and the **Foyer Exhibit Cases**. All exhibit cases lock.

**The Fine Arts Gallery** consists of three wall areas: the east wall is 24' wide by 7'6" high. The south wall is 24' wide by 7'6" high and the west wall is 17' wide by 7'6" high. All of this space is well lit by track lighting. The remaining gallery wall space consists of the west wall—divided into two sections by alcove seating—each measuring 18' wide by 7'6" high. This gallery space is lit by artificial lighting.

In addition the gallery consists of an exhibit case 10' wide and 4'10" high. It is divided into three sections: the left and right sections are 4'10" high by 34" wide and 25" deep. The center section is 4'10" high, 46" wide and 25" deep. The exhibit case is well lit and has adjustable glass shelves.

There are also two pedestal cases located in the gallery. They measure 28" wide and 28" deep and 5' high. Each case sits on a base 32" high. They are well lit and the covers are made of Plexiglas.

**The Foyer Exhibit Case** is 13'10" wide and 4'10" high. It is divided into three sections: the left and right sections are 4'10" high, 46" wide and 25" deep. The center section is 4'10" high, 70" wide and 25" deep. The exhibit case is well lit and has adjustable glass shelves.

### **Turner Community Library—831 S. 55<sup>th</sup> Street (inside the Arthur C. Waugh Community Center)**

The exhibit space at the Turner Library consists of a locking display case in the hallway just outside the library. The case is approximately 12' long and 4' high with four adjustable shelves.
